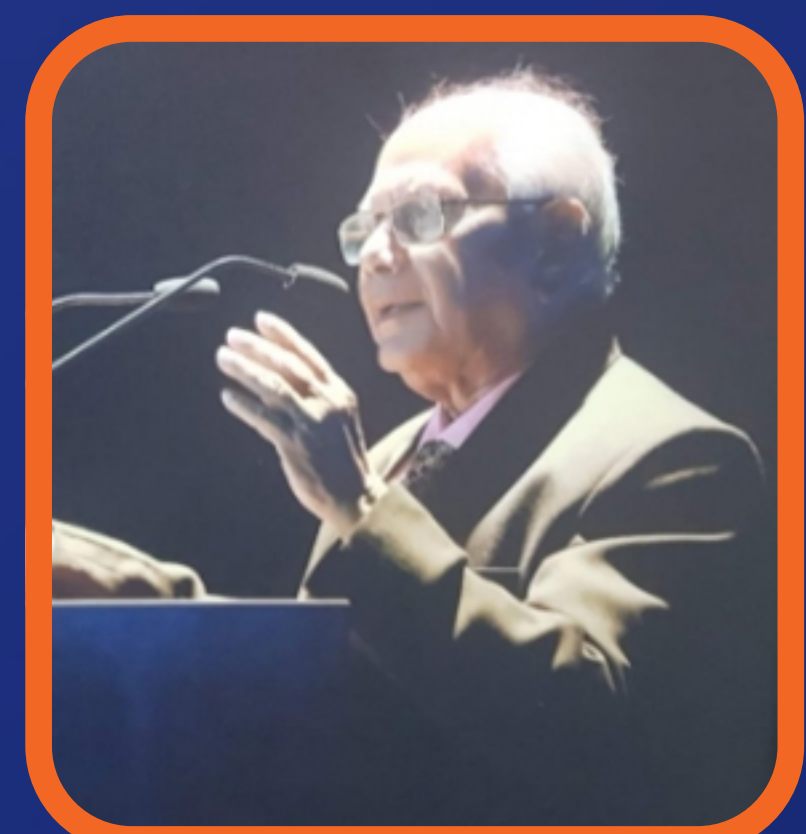

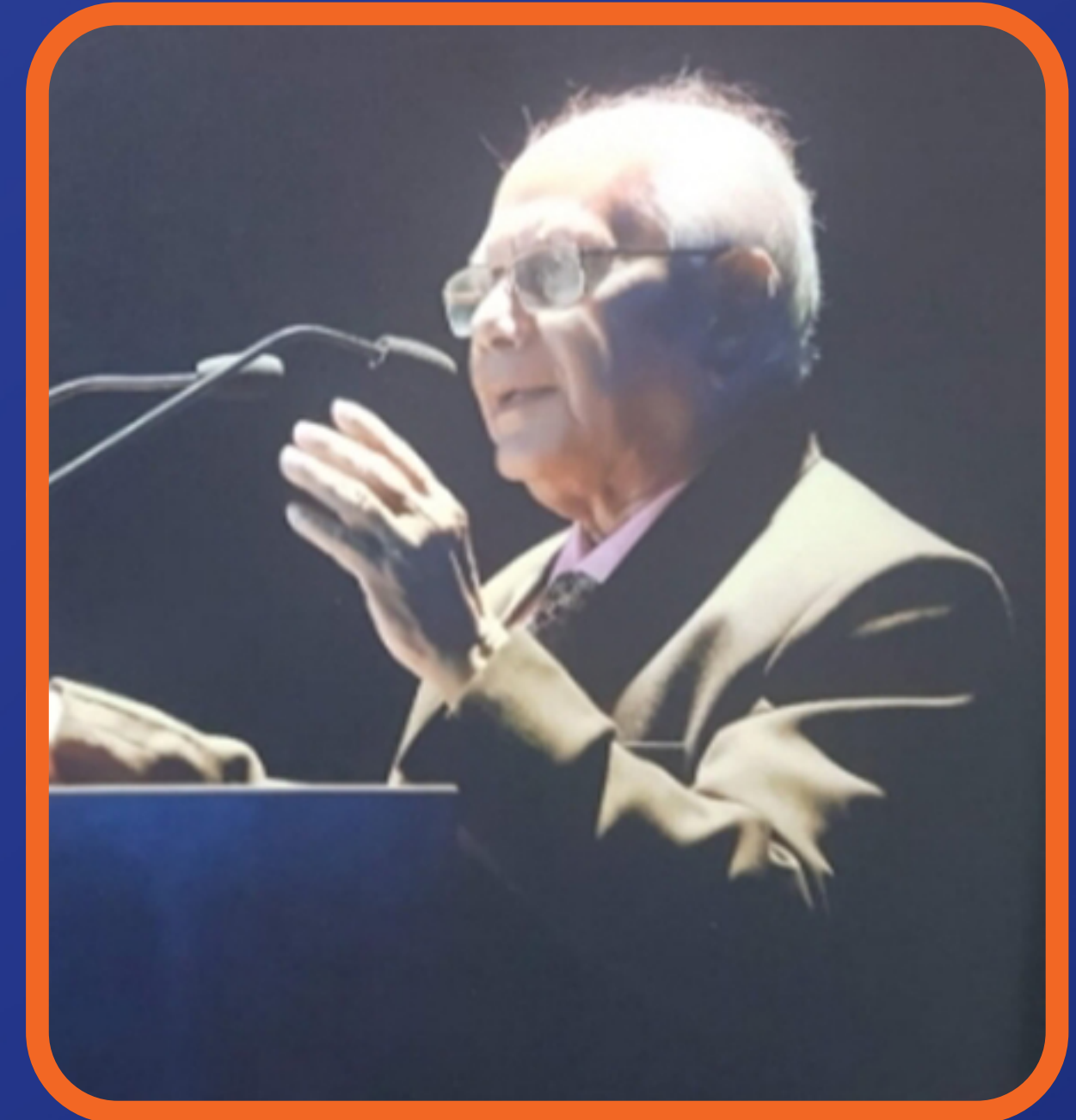

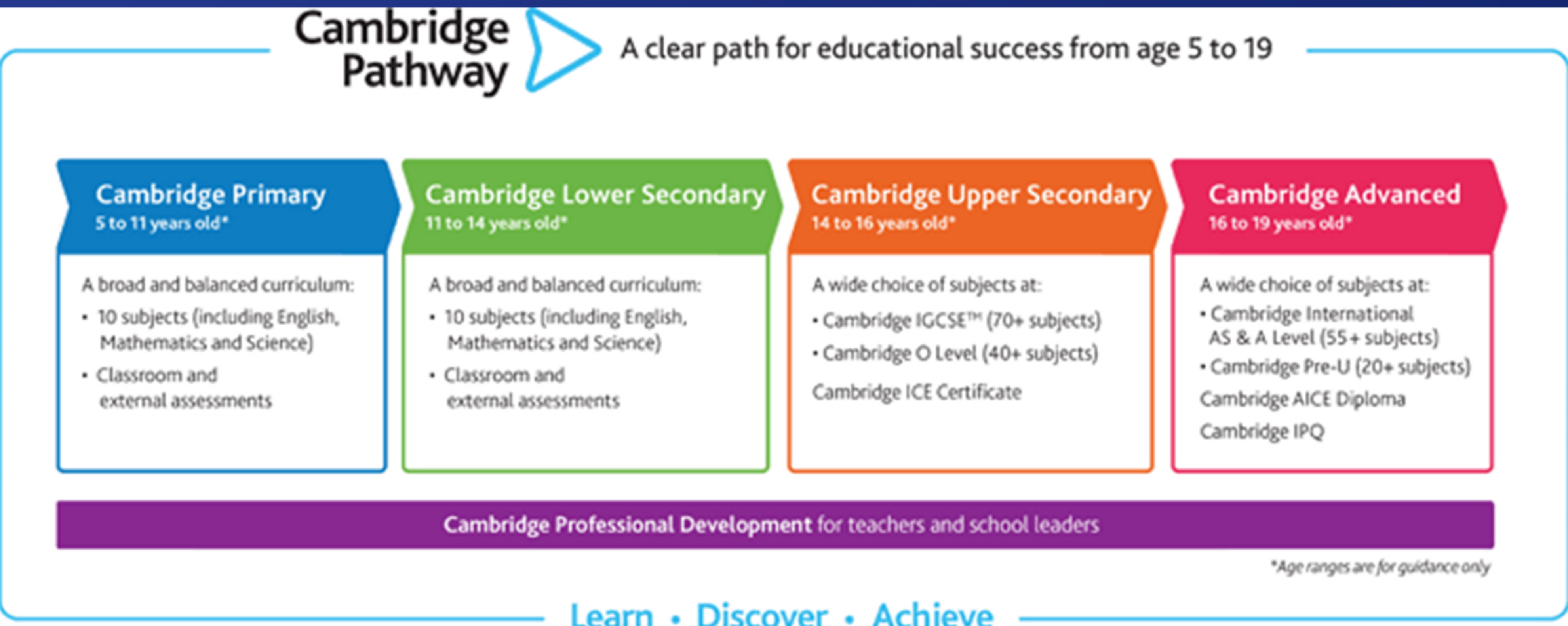
It's vital that teaching methodology in our school remains a diverse mix of the most recent innovations in education & is based on the latest findings in tutoring research.

MRG School is the 11th School in Delhi that received approval for Cambridge Assessment International Education and is providing Cambridge curriculum since April 2021.

Currently, Cambridge curriculum is offered till Grade V at MRG School. Its wide range of subjects and flexibility gives the chance to shape the curriculum so that it is exciting and relevant for their own students. Cambridge students have the chance to acquire the knowledge and skills they need to achieve at school, university and beyond. Cambridge International helps students become confident, responsible, reflective, innovative and engaged, ready to tackle the demands of tomorrow’s world, capable of shaping a better world for the future. The four stages of Cambridge lead seamlessly from primary to secondary and pre-university years. Each stage Cambridge Primary, Cambridge Lower Secondary, Cambridge Upper Secondary and Cambridge Advanced–builds on the learners’ development from the previous one, but can also be offered separately.

Bridge Programme
